Volunteer Opportunities

- **Rhythm That Moves Chairperson:** Oversees the committees responsible for the annual band/choir fundraiser. Committee members help the chairperson as needed with the planning of the event.
- **Fundraising:** Chairperson would coordinate specific fundraisers throughout the year. Wreath sales committee members help when needed for the distribution of the wreaths when they arrive at school.
- **Parent Representative:** Representatives are needed for each grade level – 5th – 12th. This representative would communicate with parents from their grade level and recruit volunteers when needed.
- **Publicity:** Communication with the local media regarding upcoming events, honors received, etc.
- **Uniforms:** Fitting for marching uniforms as well as winter concert uniforms. Also, during marching season, volunteers are needed for distribution and returns of the uniforms before and after games.
- **Band Camp Chaperone:** Spend time in late July with the Laker Marching Band at GVSU. Volunteers will help the band camp coordinators as needed with day/evening activities and supervision.
- **Volunteer Coordinator:** Work with parent representatives from each grade level to ensure volunteers are in place for each activity.
- **Football Games (50/50 raffle):** Sell 50/50 raffle tickets prior to the start of each home football game. Assist the treasurer as needed.
- **Bus Chaperones:** Ride to and from the band competitions to supervise the band students.
- **Parade Volunteers:** Walk with the band during the Memorial Day parade and the Coast Guard Parade to distribute water as needed.
- **Trailer Hauling:** Tow, with your own vehicle, band trailers to the band competitions and football games.
- **Winter Storage:** Provide inside storage for two equipment trailers.
- **Photography/Videography:** Photograph and/or video the band at concerts, football games, competitions and special events.
- **Jazz Night:** Help organize the dessert sale held during intermission of the jazz concert featuring a guest artist.
- **Hospitality:** Organizes volunteers to donate cookies to the winter and spring concerts. Also, helps set up and serve concert refreshments.
- **Equipment Coordinators:** Assists the band directors with equipment during football games and competitions.
