Dear Fifth Grade Parents:

School is beginning and it's time to start band! Starting TOMORROW (Friday, September 5) we will be fitting students with the instrument that works the best for them. We hope to be done with this in the first week. At that time, we will develop a band list of all the students and the instruments they will be playing. Just about everyone will get their first instrument choice, but some students may need to play a second choice if we need more of that instrument. This is where you come in. Before we can fit each student, we would like you to talk to your child about participation in band and fill out the section at the bottom of this page. We need to have the bottom portion of the page to be returned when the student comes for his or her fitting. After we are done with all the students, we will post a list at school and on our website detailing which instrument best fits your son or daughter.

Each student needs to get an instrument to play. The best choice is to rent an instrument from a reputable dealer. Meyer Music (located by the Lakes Mall) will be at our fifth grade parent meeting on September 11th with instruments so you can pick one up here at the school. You can also go directly to the store and rent one. If you are purchasing or borrowing a used instrument, please have it checked at the shop at Meyer to make sure it is a quality instrument and in good working condition. We would like all the trumpet students to start on a trumpet, not a cornet. Also, please do not be tempted by the inexpensive instruments that are popping up at Sam's Club, Wal-Mart and Meijer. They will not play well, last long and are nearly impossible to repair. Your child will also need the book, "Tradition of Excellence". This is available at Meyer Music. If you forget the title, just tell them that your child goes to Spring Lake – they have the name of the book on file. One other purchase that would really jumpstart your child's progress is Smartmusic. It only costs \$40 per year and is an amazing way to get going quickly on an instrument. We will always have all the information at www.springlakebands.org Even though it's not a required class, we'd love for all the fifth graders to take part in band – it's such a great experience! Please encourage your child to be a part of this class and **remember that it is a minimum one- year commitment.** Many times, it takes several months for the instrument to "click" with the student, so quitting after a few weeks not only messes up the scheduling, but isn't indicative of the student's possible ability on the instrument. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us anytime. We're looking forward to a GREAT year!
