- 6:30 AM Three 56 passenger (maximum 167 seats available) motor coaches arrive at **Spring Lake High School**, 16140 148th Ave, Spring Lake, MI 49456 (616-846-5502) for loading.
- 7:30 AM Motor coach provided by **Compass Coach** (989-773-0471) departs the school. *(6.25 hours have been allotted for the drive; plus 1 hour for rest stops/meals on your own along the route; plus 1 hour for border crossing.)*
- 12:00 PM Stop for lunch. *(by own expense)*
Two hours from arrival, please call your Tour Director with your estimated arrival time.
- 3:45 PM Arrive and meet your **Tour Director**, who will accompany the group exclusively throughout the tour.
- 4:00 PM Check into the **Holiday Inn Toronto Airport**, 970 Dixon Rd, Toronto, Ontario M9W 1J9 (416-675-7611 / 888-465-4329)
- 5:00 PM Transfer by motor coach to dinner.

- 7:30 PM Arrive at the theater and be seated.

- 6:30 PM Transfer by motor coach to dinner.
- 7:00 PM Arrive at Medieval Times and be seated.
- 7:30 PM Experience a **Medieval Times Dinner and Tournament**, 10 Dufferin St, Toronto, ON M6K 3C3 (416-260-1170 / 888-935-6878)
- 9:45 PM Transfer by motor coach to the hotel.
Private hotel security will be provided.

Saturday, March 29, 2025

- 8:00 AM Breakfast at the hotel.
- 9:00 AM Check-out of the hotel and load the motor coach.
- 9:30 AM Transfer by motor coach.
- 11:00 AM Enjoy lunch and explore the **Table Rock Centre** at the heart of the falls. *(Lunch by own expense)*
- 12:30 PM Transfer by motor coach or walk (weather pending).
- 1:00 PM Ascend to the **Skylon Tower Observation Deck**.
- 2:15 PM Motor coaches depart to return to the school. *(6.25 hours have been allotted for the drive; plus 1 hour for rest stops/meals on your own along the route; plus 1 hour for border crossing)*
- 5:30 PM Free time is included for **Dinner**. *(each participant will be provided with \$15)*
In the event of a delay enroute home, please call our 24-hour service (1-800-654-4560 then "0"), give the name of your school and expected arrival time.
- 10:30 PM Arrive back at the school.

PLEASE NOTE: *In keeping with Educational Tours, Inc.'s commitment to safety and security, we prepare each itinerary in accordance with the DOT rules and regulations, giving drivers a minimum of 9 hours off each night and a maximum of 15 hours on duty during any 24-hour period. We reserve the right to revise the itinerary, at any time, due to unforeseen circumstances such as traffic, road closures, site closures, weather, etc. Your Tour Manager will consult with the Group Leader and drivers on any changes.*

ENTRY INTO CANADA - *All passengers must be equipped with proper identification; The Department of Homeland Security requires that most U.S. citizens and foreign nationals need to present a PASSPORT, PASSPORT CARD or ENHANCED DRIVER'S LICENSE (for those states that offer it). Passport Card and Enhanced Driver's License are not valid for air travel to cross the US border. *OFFICIAL EXCEPTION* - Groups of U.S. citizen children ages 18 and under, when traveling with a school or religious group, social organization, or sports team, will be able to enter under adult supervision with originals or copies of their birth certificates, or other proof of citizenship. ETI strongly recommends you bring original birth certificates as photocopies may result in a delay at the border. Your group must also present a letter on organizational letterhead with the following information: The name of the group and supervising adult, a list of the children on the trip (including their primary address, phone number, date of birth, place of birth, and name of at least one parent or legal guardian for each child), and a written and signed statement of the supervising adult certifying that he or she has obtained parental or legal guardian consent for each participating child. Non US citizens may be required to have a VISA. Those 19 and older must still have a Passport, Passport Card, or enhanced Driver's License (for those states that offer it). Without proper identification, border authorities may not allow you to cross the border. Note: Anyone with prior DUI arrest should do research to confirm you will be allowed entrance into Canada.*
