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Classroom Rules/Procedures:

- Be considerate and respectful to other students and our facilities.
- Students must have a pencil with them during class.
- Please use the restroom on the way to class.
- After entering the room, get your instrument and sit in your assigned seat.
- Do not start warming up until you are in your seat (percussion warm up on drum pads).
- Once you enter the band room, do not leave the band room without permission.

- Use instrument masks when playing inside. If playing outside, masks will not be required.

Grading Policy:

60% Daily grade – participation, organization, behavior, attitude, following class rules, etc...
(*Students will receive a grade every two weeks – 5 points per week*)
30% Concerts
10% Playing tests/audition

Practice:

Students will not be required to turn in practice slips. It is an expectation however that students will practice at home.
